Connecting with District Achievement

The Distinguished District Program focuses on club quality and member satisfaction and recognizes Districts that meet goals in growth and educational achievement through the support of their clubs. It is also a management tool to focus Districts on increasing membership, forming new clubs, and ensuring clubs are meeting the needs of their members.

Qualifying Requirements

A qualifying requirement is a prerequisite or prior condition for participation in the program. If a qualifying requirement is not met, Distinguished recognition may not be received. To be considered for recognition, Districts must meet two qualifying requirements:

1. Submit the Division and Area Directors Training Report to World Headquarters by September 30 showing that 85% of Division and Area Directors were trained.	2. Submit the District Success Plan to World Headquarters by September 30 .
